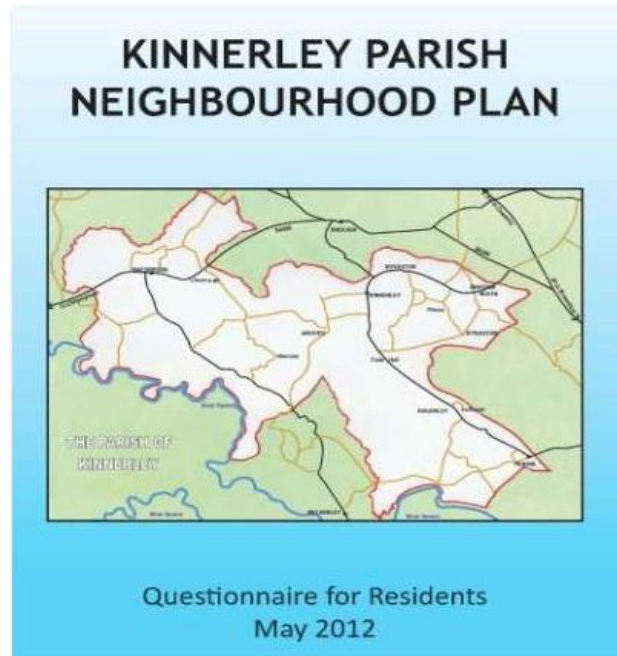


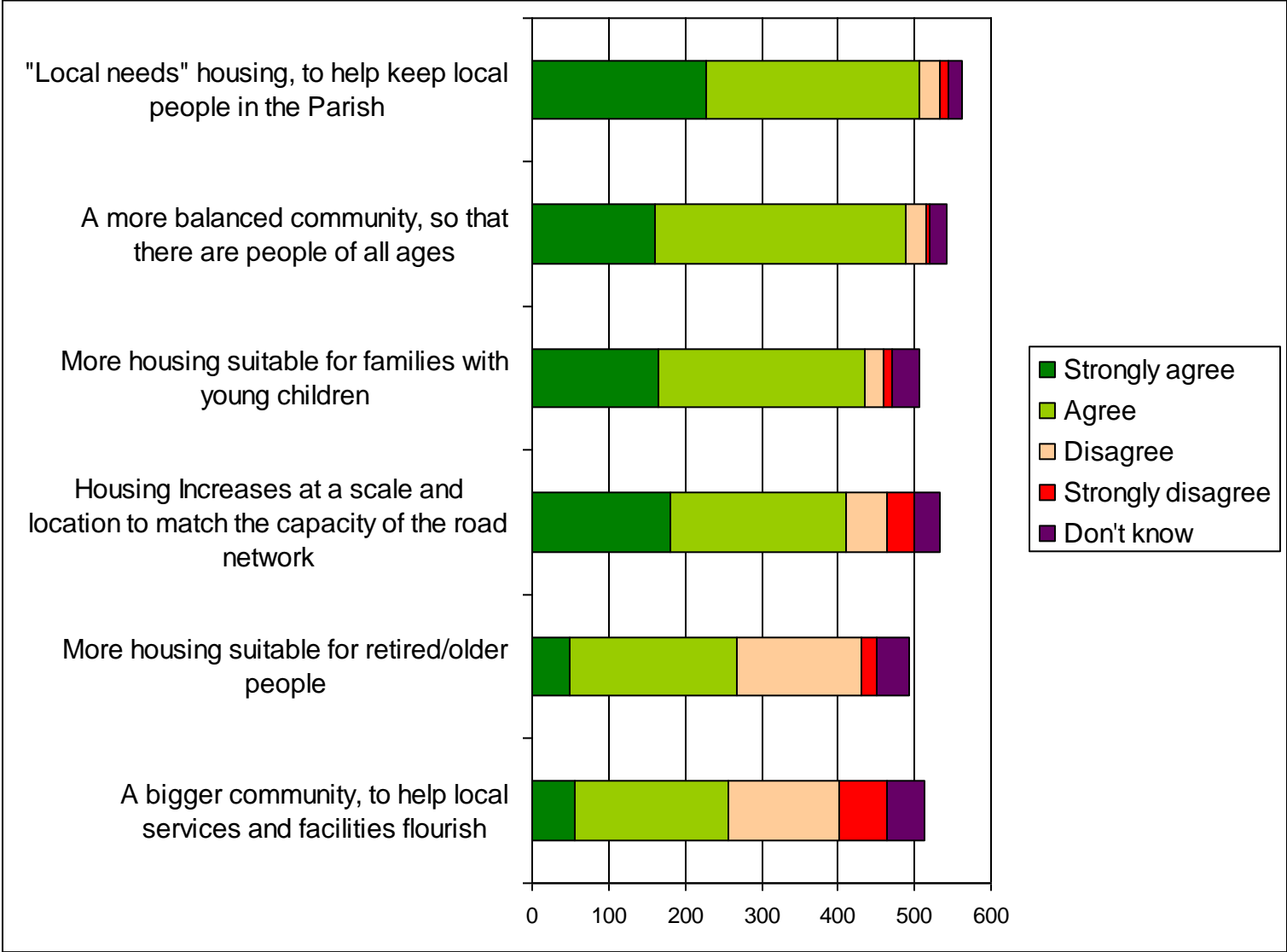

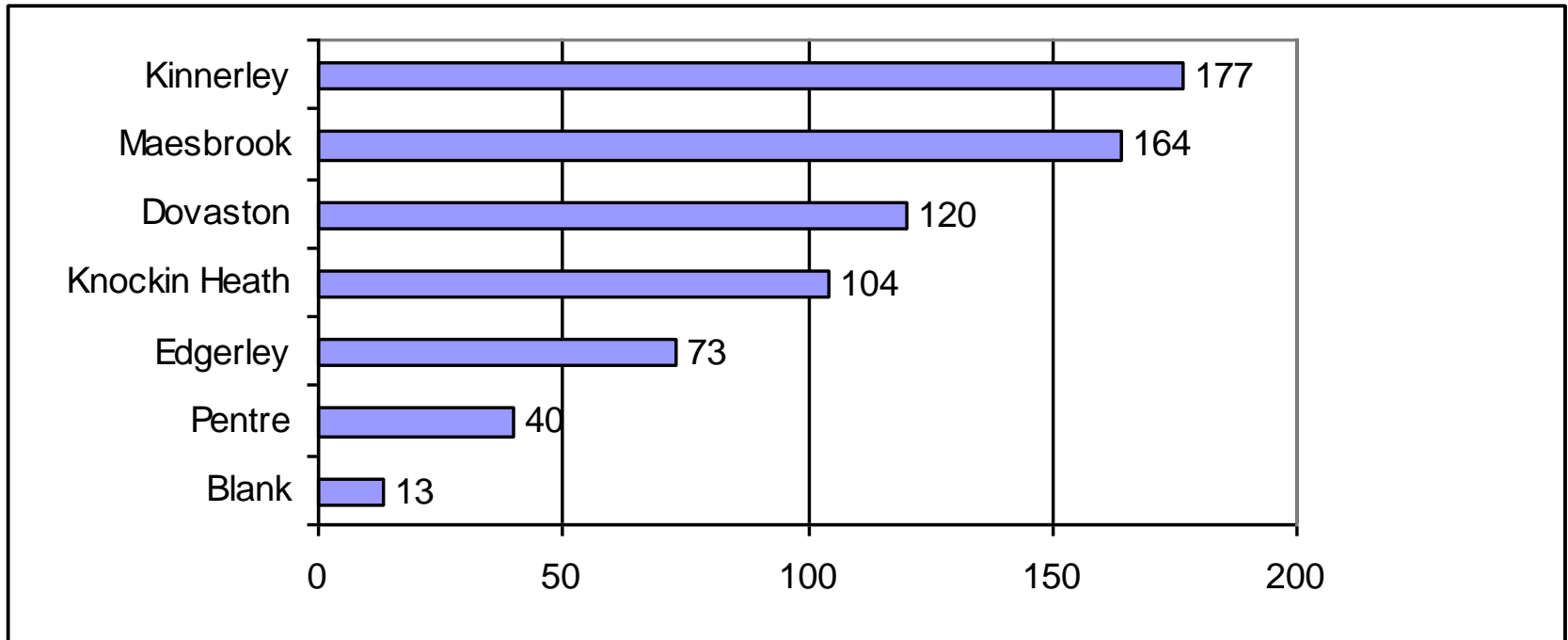
Questionnaire Responses

- Together, representing the views of 691 residents of Kinnerley Parish.

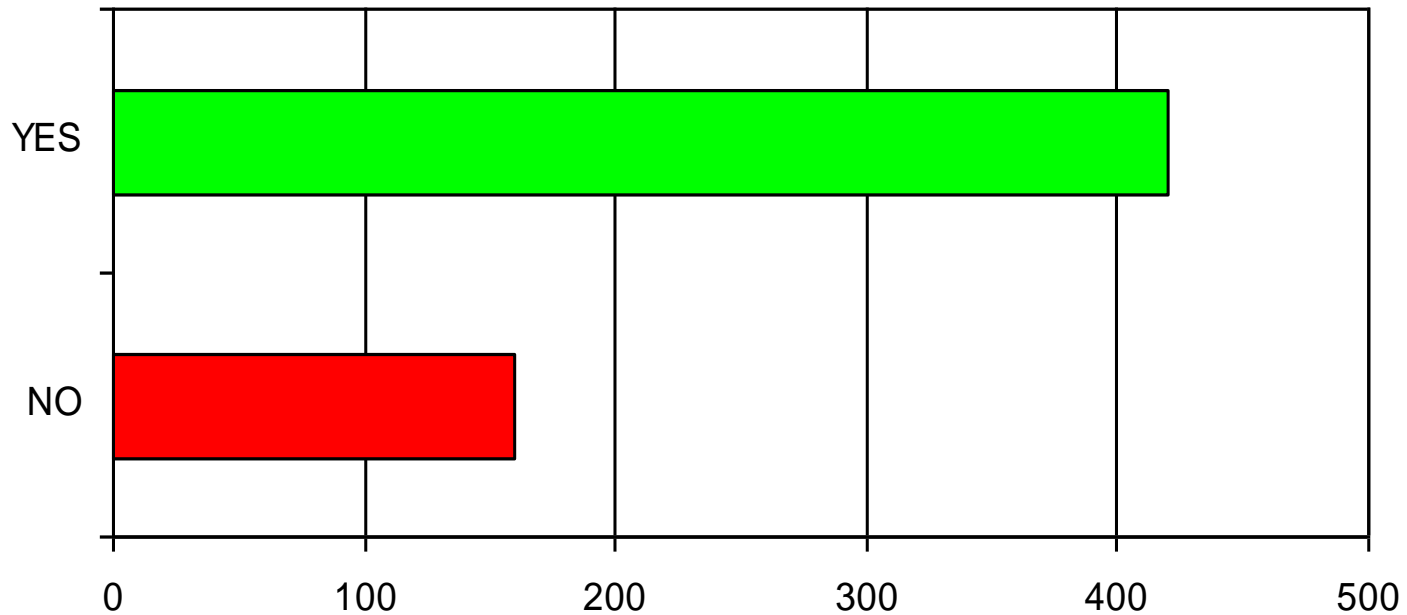
What sort of community do we want Kinnerley Parish to be?



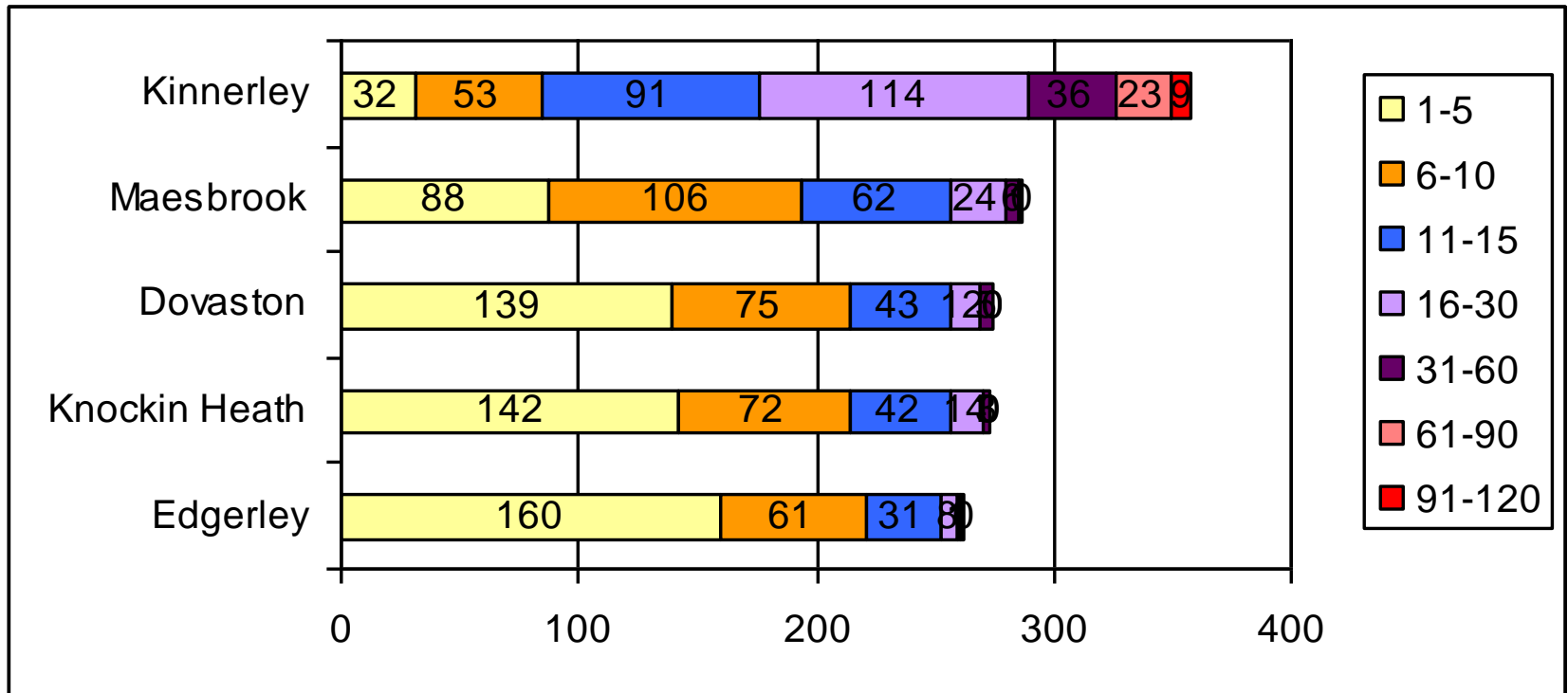

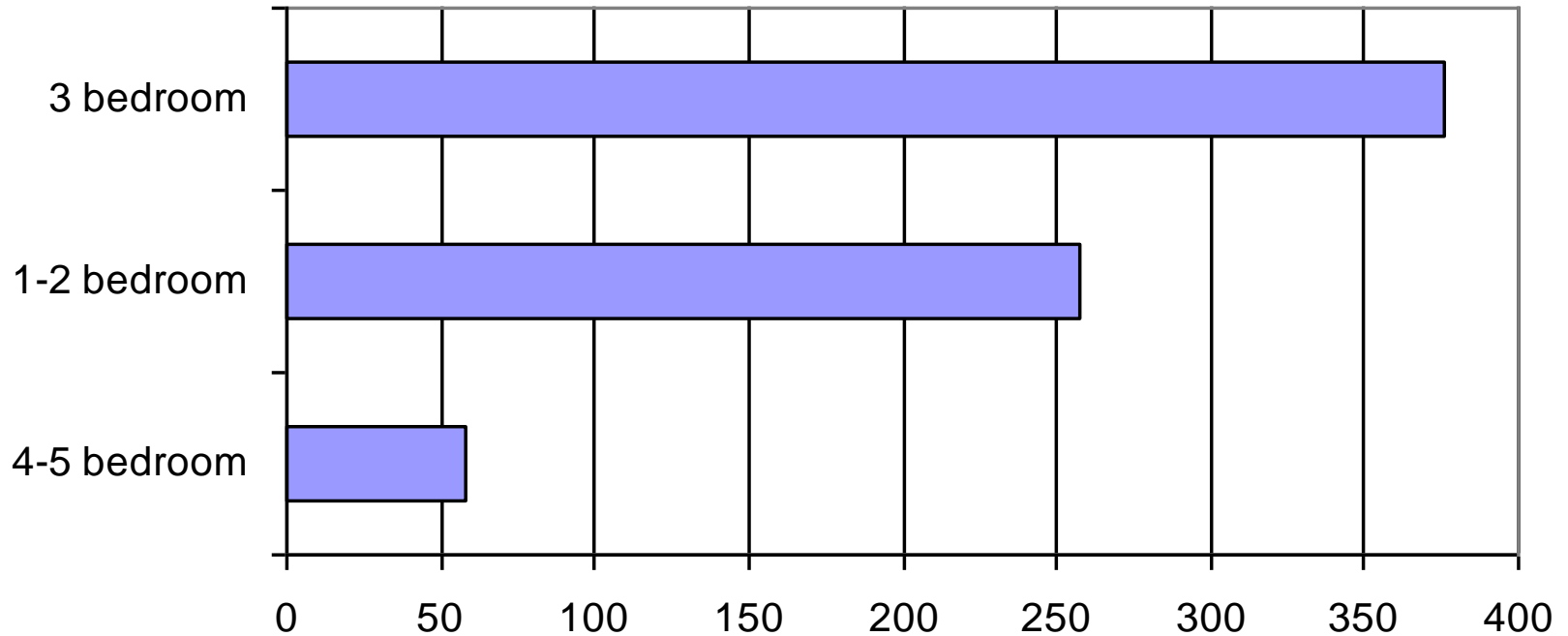
Do we need more houses in the next 15 years?



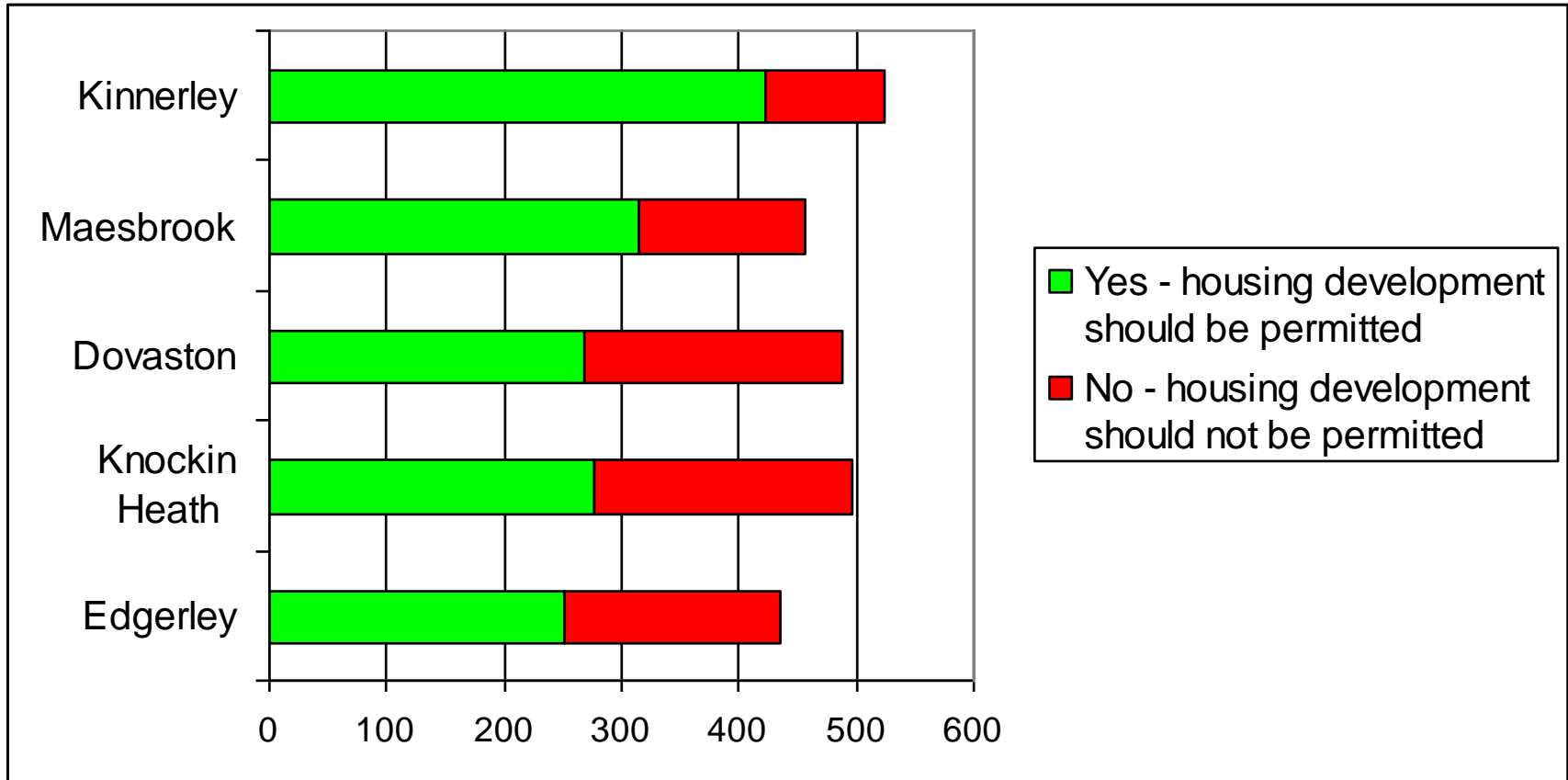

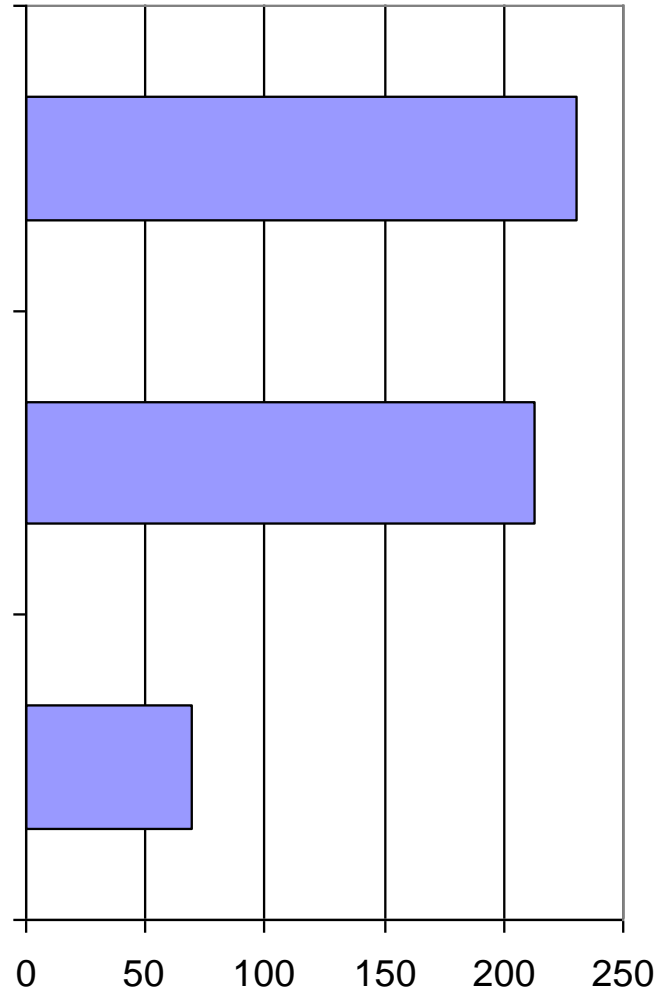


Development Boundary?

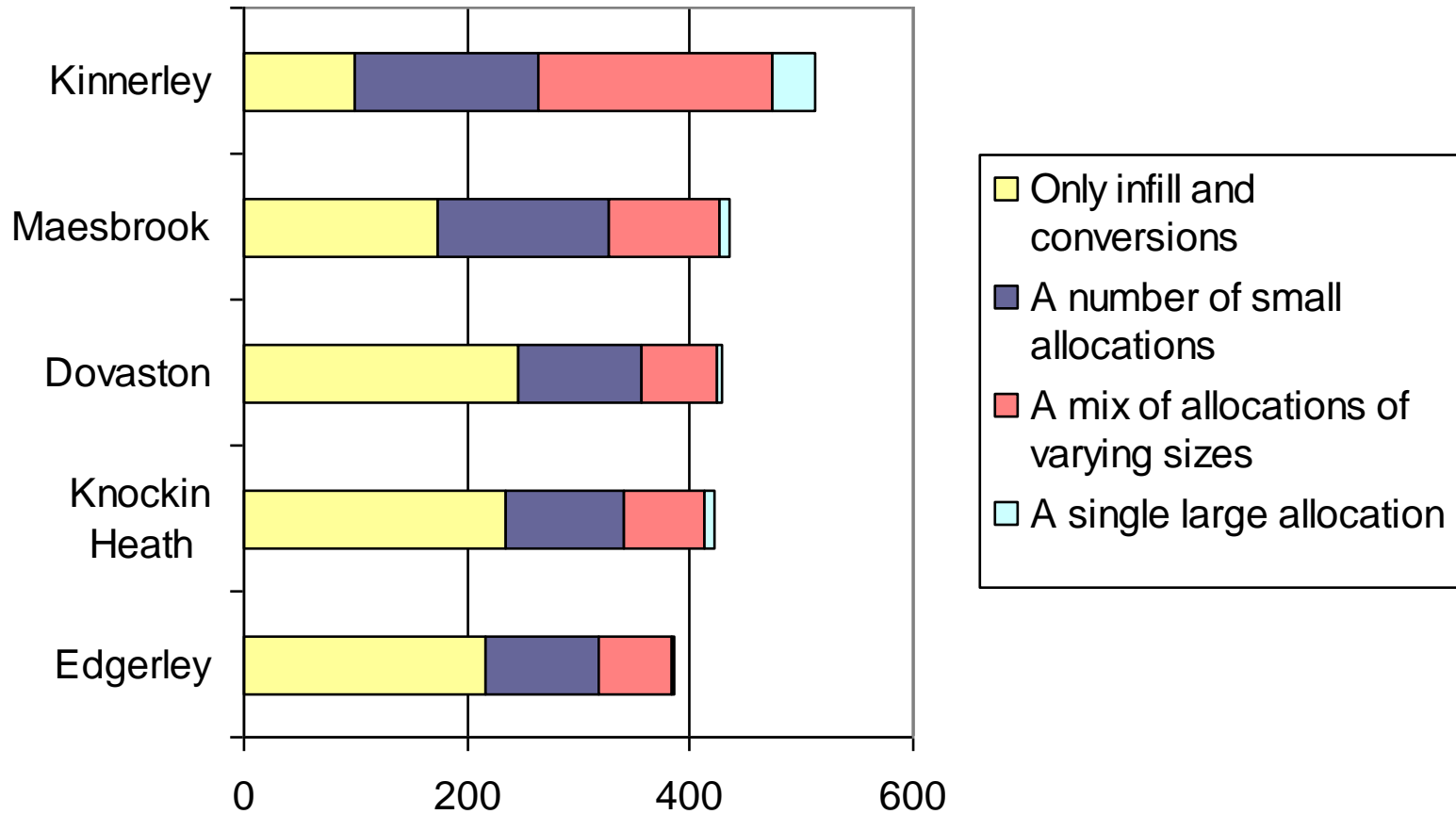
Decide through the Neighbourhood Plan process where future development should be sited, and then draw new development boundaries around these sites.

Retain existing development boundary

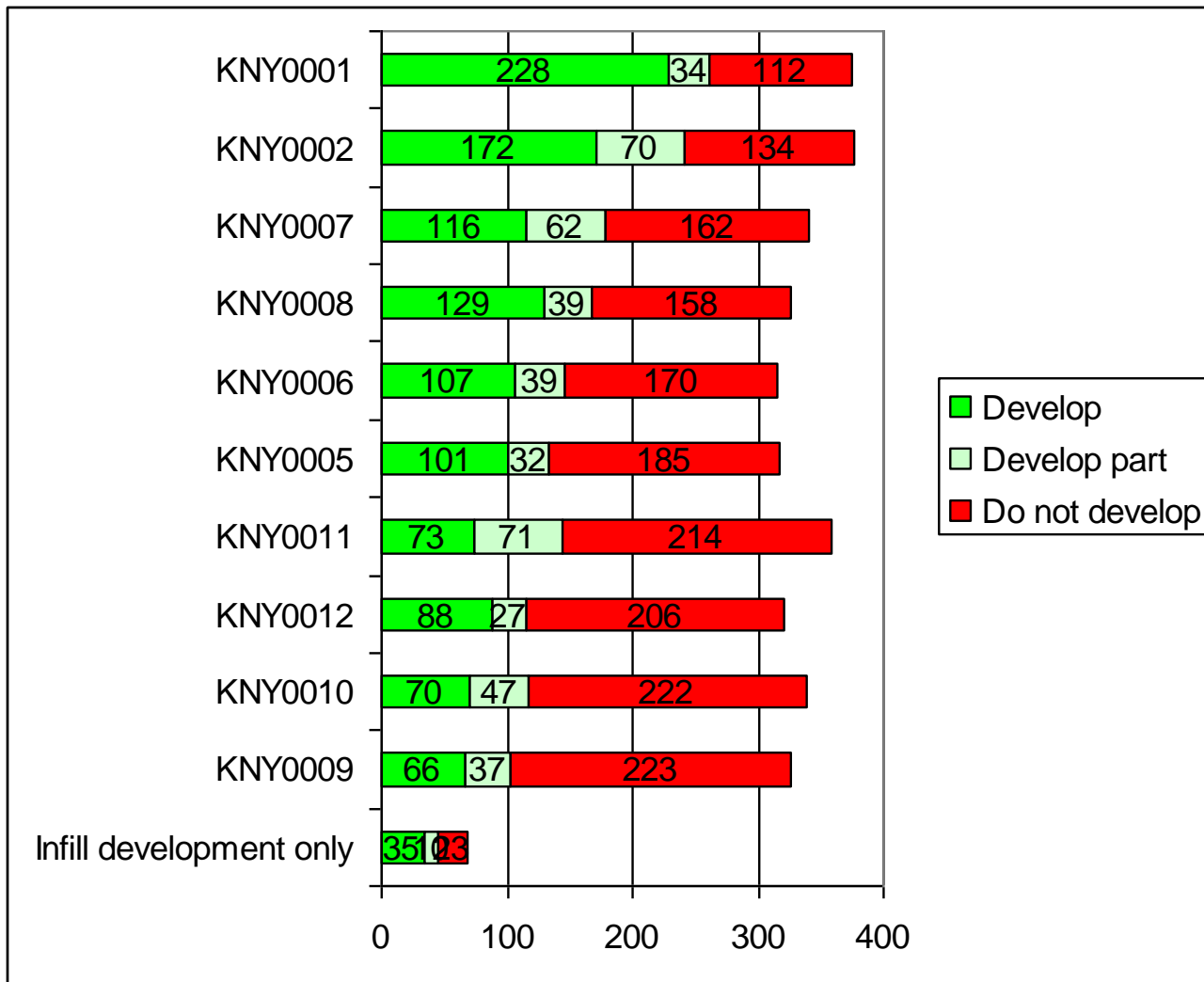
Identify key sites for development to take place where appropriate, but have no development boundaries.



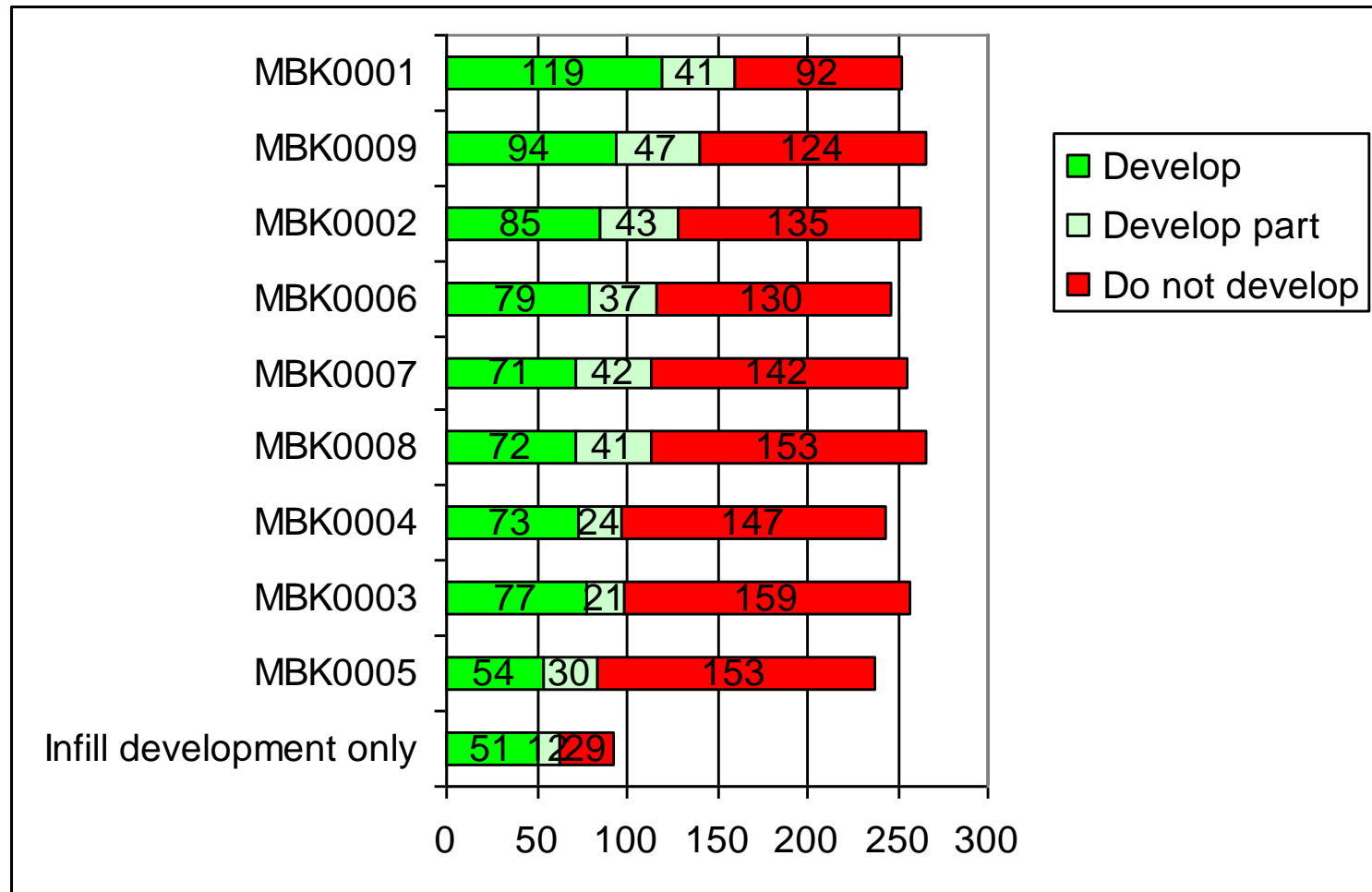
What size of development site in the various settlements?



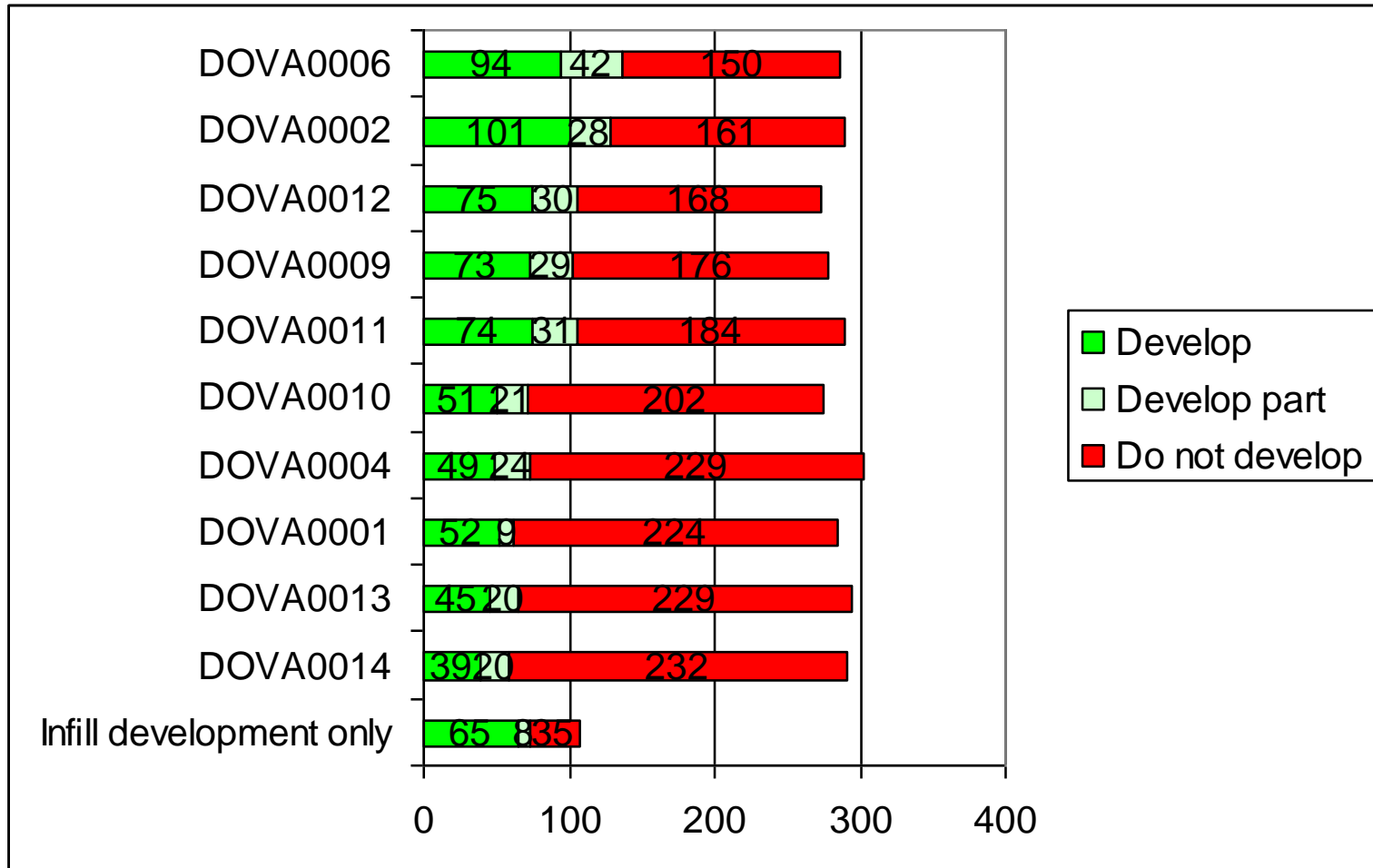
Kinnerley Potential Housing Development Sites



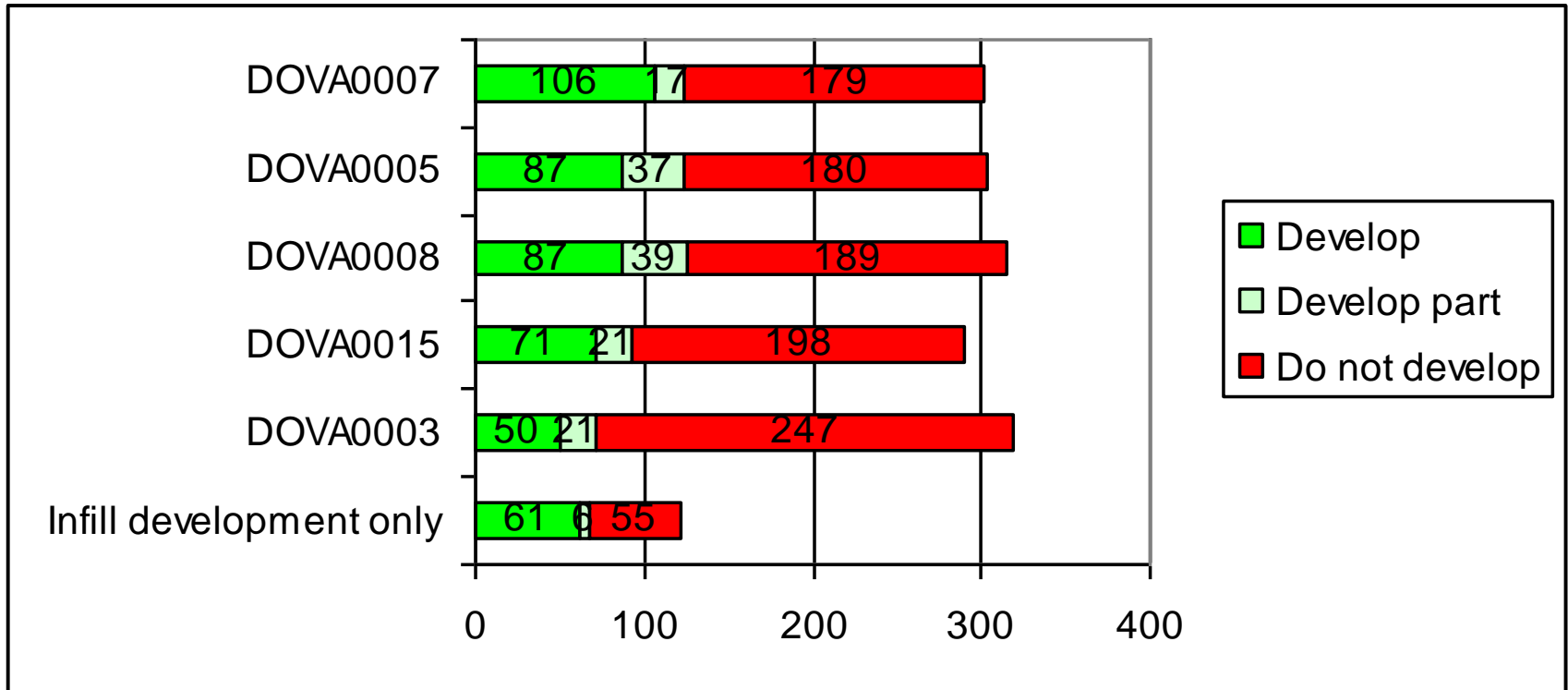
Maesbrook Potential Housing Development Sites
